
TEEN GIRL

TEEN GIRL has no specific name as she represents the possibility of being all teen girls. She has recently lost her mother.

Her father has decided to bring her to Cowra to help her understand the Cowra Breakout which she is studying at school.

She is in Year 10 and has a tendency to hang with the wrong crowd. She has been drinking socially and sneaking out of the house.

Through her solo song 'Afraid of the Dark', we learn of her fears. She is frustrated that her dad has become emotionally distant at a time she finds she really needs him.

She learns about the Cowra POW Breakout and feels an empathy growing within her for other people's stories. She is saddened to hear of the treatment of Aboriginal people at the time of the Breakout.



AUSTRALIAN SOLDIER represents many different Australian soldiers serving in Cowra in 1944.

He explores how his interactions with Japanese soldiers affected him.

We learn how broken he is.

Our AUSTRALIAN SOLDIER was posted to B Compound of Cowra Camp in 1944.

He has fond memories of the Italians and through him we learn about the Japanese POWs.

We learn through the course of the play that his wife is no longer in his life. A trip to Japan with his daughter helped him understand the Japanese soldier in a new way.

He transitions between present and his memories.

He loves his community and recalls words and interactions with some of his elders that have helped to form him.

He wants to experience true freedom and sometimes struggles with understanding his place in his community.

He grapples with the truth of his history whilst living within the wider Cowra community.

He wonders at times why there has been acceptance towards the Japanese in Cowra and if we can use the lessons of Cowra-Japan stories to help us move forward with our Indigenous community too.


